SPECIALISTS' TRAINING IN TOURISM, RECREATION AND HEALTH-RELATED FITNESS: PROFESSIONAL DICTIONARIES

The article deals with the topical issue of professional dictionaries for specialists' training in tourism, recreation and health-related fitness. The current body of recent research and publications provides clear evidence of much attention being paid to various aspects of specialists' training in tourism, recreation and health-related fitness. Specialized dictionaries have also been the focus of scientific consideration on a regular basis. Nevertheless, professional specialized dictionaries in the increasing sphere of tourism, recreation and health-related fitness require more detailed consideration, analysis and investigation.

Due to the actuality of professional enhancement in the growing fields of tourism, recreation and health-related fitness, and the significant role of dictionaries in the course of this practice, the aim of the research is to examine the specialized dictionaries of the sphere. Tasks of the research imply distinguishing and analysing the features of professional dictionaries for the field specialists' education. Subsequently, the object of research is specialists' training in tourism, recreation and health-related fitness, and the subject concerns the specialized dictionaries for professional development in this sphere. Professional dictionaries for specialists' training in tourism, recreation and health-related fitness have been examined due to the methods of literature analysis and comparative analysis of the printed and internet resources.

The use of specialized professional dictionaries is considered to be one of the best means for the efficient skill sets enhancement and a useful resource in the workplace, as they provide detailed definitions and proper usage of special terms within the professional language of any field specialists, namely in the growing sphere of tourism, recreation and health-related fitness. Further research prospects suggest the study and comparative analysis of specialized professional dictionaries in the field of tourism, recreation and health-related fitness in the English and Ukrainian languages.

Tourism and recreation have always been among the booming industry sectors across the globe. The spheres are very important aspects for not only a country's economy but also its global standing, as they bring in wealth, growth, employment, etc.

Modern tourism is closely linked to development and encompasses a growing number of new destinations. This global spread of tourism in industrialised and developed states has produced economic and employment benefits in many related sectors [23].

Nowadays, an increasing number of travellers want to keep up with their healthy habits when they travel for business or pleasure, or take recreational trips specifically to improve their health and overall fitness. There are resorts and vacation spots all over the world that offers fitness tourism to a high level.

The new demand creates more job opportunities in tourism industry and many related spheres, subsequently increasing the educational needs of the staff engaged in the relevant service provision. This necessitates more attention being paid to various aspects of professional education for the allied field specialists.

Professional education is a formal specialized training about a particular profession in which learners are taught the central concepts, principles, and techniques, and how these are applied in real practice, and the learners also acquire the necessary competencies needed for proper practice and behaviour [25].

Every industry is constantly evolving, so employees should use professional development and specialists' training opportunities to expand their knowledge base. Professional specialized dictionaries are beyond doubt among the main reference resources, consulting which occupies a considerable amount of time and effort of any field specialist, thus becoming an integral part of their professional training.

A specialized dictionary is a dictionary that covers a relatively restricted set of phenomena, usually within one or more subject fields [5]. Specialized dictionaries are used to understand concepts in specific domains, especially where those concepts are not part of the general vocabulary, or having meanings that differ from ordinary languages [12].

Specialised dictionaries are defined by the specialised nature of the subjects they treat, focusing on particular subject fields, professional practices or even leisure activities such as sports with the aim of helping the user to acquire specialised knowledge, read specialised texts or engage in specialised translation [13].

The current body of recent research and publications provides clear evidence of much attention being paid to various aspects of specialists' training in tourism, recreation and health-related fitness. The scholars' interest comprised numerous issues, in particular the professional training in tourism and hospitality [27; 28; 30], famous chefs of today [19], sports and recreation [2], fitness level [9], educational resources in this sphere [29], etc.

Professional specialized dictionaries have also been the focus of scientific consideration on a regular basis. The researchers such as Yamada S. [26], Al-Jarf R. [1], Durovic Z. [10], Fuertes-Olivera P. A. [11], Van der Merwe M. [24], Bergenholtz H., Tarp S. [5], Grefenstette G., Muchemi L. [12], Humbley J. [13] concerned the fields of health care, business and computer science, marine engineering, translation, higher education and many others.

Notwithstanding many scholars' attention being paid to different aspects of the topic, professional specialized dictionaries in the increasing sphere of tourism, recreation and health-related fitness require more detailed consideration, analysis and investigation.

Due to the **actuality** of professional enhancement in the growing fields of tourism, recreation and health-related fitness, and the significant role of dictionaries in the course of this practice, the **aim** of the research is to examine the specialized dictionaries of the sphere. **Tasks** of the research imply distinguishing and analysing the features of professional dictionaries for the field specialists' education. Subsequently, the **object** of research is specialists' training in tourism, recreation and health-related fitness, and the **subject** concerns the specialized dictionaries for professional development in this sphere.

The **methods** of literature analysis and comparative analysis of the printed and internet resources [3; 4; 6; 7; 8; 14; 15; 16; 17; 18; 20; 21; 22], reveal the professional specialized dictionaries for specialists' training in tourism, recreation and health-related fitness to be characterized as follows.

Professional dictionaries in tourism

The Dictionary of Tourism. The author's objective in the second edition of The Dictionary of Tourism is identical to that of the first edition – to provide a reference source for those choosing a career in some facet of the multidimensional field of tourism and for those who simply desire information on terms used in the industry. Professional dictionaries in recreation

Professional dictionaries in health-related fitness

Dictionary of Public Health Education and Health Promotion. Written for public health professionals and students, the second edition of the dictionary, includes definitions for terms and concepts frequently used in public health education and promotion. The dictionary also provides a useful study aid when preparing for the exam to become a certified health education specialist.

Food and Fitness: A Dictionary of Diet and Exercise. This accessible dictionary is packed full of authoritative information on foods and drinks, types of diet, sports and activities, physiology, and calorie requirements. New services produce more employment prospects, demanding relevant professional education of the specialists. Professional development and learning opportunities are great ways to stay up-to-date on industry knowledge and trends.

One of the best means for the efficient specialists training and their skill sets enhancement is considered the use of specialized professional dictionaries. They are found to be an important and useful resource in the workplace, as they provide definitions for special terms, their origin, evolvement and proper usage within the professional language of any field specialists, namely in the growing sphere of tourism, recreation and health-related fitness.

Further **research prospects** suggest the study and comparative analysis of specialized professional dictionaries in the field of tourism, recreation and health-related fitness in the English and Ukrainian languages.

У статті розглянуто актуальне питання спеціалізованих фахових словників для професійної підготовки фахівців у сфері туризму, рекреації та оздоровчого фітнесу. Аналіз сучасних досліджень та публікацій свідчить про значну увагу вчених до різних аспектів професійної підготовки фахівців у галузі туризму, рекреації та оздоровчого фітнесу. Спеціалізовані словники також перебувають у центрі постійної уваги науковців. Однак, зважаючи на постійний розвиток сфери туризму, рекреації та оздоровчого фітнесу, спеціалізовані фахові словники цієї галузі потребують детальнішого розгляду, аналізу та дослідження.

З огляду на актуальність удосконалення професійних умінь у сфері туризму, рекреації та оздоровчого фітнесу та значну роль словників у цій практиці, метою даного дослідження є вивчення фахових словників даної галузі. Завдання дослідження полягають у визначенні та аналізі особливостей спеціалізованих фахових словників для професійної підготовки фахівців цієї сфери. Таким чином, об'єктом даного дослідження є підготовка фахівців у галузі туризму, рекреації та оздоровчого фітнесу, а предметом — фахові словники для професійного розвитку в цій сфері. Спеціалізовані фахові словники для професійної підготовки фахівців у галузі туризму, рекреації та оздоровчого фітнесу розглянуто й досліджено методами літературного аналізу і порівняльного аналізу друкованих та інтернет-ресурсів.

Використання спеціалізованих фахових словників є одним із найкращих засобів та корисним ресурсом ефективного удосконалення професійних умінь й навичок для широкого застосування у фаховій діяльності, ураховуючи те, що в них, як правило, точніше зазначено детальне визначення і відповідне використання спеціальної термінологічної лексики для продуктивної професійної комунікації фахівців будь-якої сфери, зокрема у розвинутій галузі туризму, рекреації та оздоровчого фітнесу. Перспективи подальших досліджень передбачають вивчення і порівняльний аналіз спеціалізованих фахових словників у сфері туризму, рекреації та оздоровчого фітнесу в англійській і українській мовах.
